This IMDG Code course is based on IMO Model Course 1.10 and provides training to your company in understanding the entire processes in transport of dangerous goods by sea.

In this course, you will learn among others:

- 1) To identify the nine hazard classes, their divisions and three packing groups.
- 2) Establishing primary hazard, subsidiary hazard and marine pollutant.
- 3) Correctly marking and labelling packaged dangerous goods.
- 4) Correctly packing packaged dangerous goods into cargo transport units.
- 5) Correctly placarding and marking cargo transport units containing dangerous goods.
- 6) Correctly completing dangerous goods transport documents.
- 7) Correctly stowing and segregating dangerous goods in packages and in cargo transport units.
- 8) Response procedures to emergency situations including fire and spillage involving dangerous goods.

This course is highly interactive with case studies, practical presentations and exercises to enhance its effectiveness and to assist the participants in gaining practical experience.

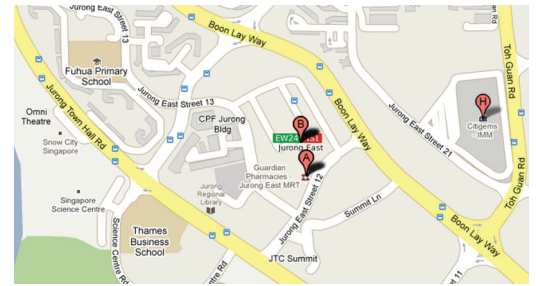

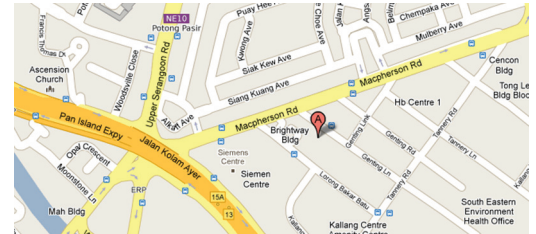
